Water Shut offs by owner in an Emergency

Property owner must notify VOG when water utility has been turned back on once turned off.

In the event that the property owner or plumber break the water shut off the owner will be charged a \$100.00 maintenance fee.

Tenant of nonpayment accounts

It is the Landlords responsibility for non-payments of tenants.

New tenant utilities will not be transferred until delinquency of prior tenant is paid in full.

VOG will make reasonable effort (48 hours in advance) to contact landlord prior to disconnections.

Landlord will not choose whether to allow disconnection or not by the Village of Greenup.

Tap Fees – Water

34" service line \$250.00

1" & over \$250.00, plus contractor fee's

Tap Fees – Gas

34" gas pipe up to 100 feet \$250.00

In excess of 100 feet - \$ 3.00 per foot

Tapping on to an existing Gas Line \$250.00

1" & over \$250.00, plus contractor fee's

Tap Fees – Electric \$250.00

Tap Fees – Sewer \$250.00

Water upgrades or new construction, water shutoff valves are required.

Electric upgrades or new construction - disconnect at bottom of meter.

Home Generator's – Wiring of transfer switch need to be installed by a licensed electrician.

Uncontrollable forces – Failure to perform (For all utilities of the VOG)
See 13.10.090 Ele. Wat. Sew. and Gas

Village of Greenup responsibility:

Water and Gas connection - the Village of Greenup is responsible for piping, connections and meter. Anything past the meter is the customer's responsibility.

Sewer – the Customer is responsible for sewer connection at sewer main to structure (home, commercial bldg., etc.).

Electricity (Overhead connections) – the customer is responsible for past connections before the weather head.

Electricity (Underground connections) – all underground utilities are the responsibility of the customer with the exception of the meter.

Code 13.16.200 Runoff and groundwater connection – amend by adding basements, crawl spaces and sump pumps.
